Our Conductor

Michael Zaugg: Managing & Artistic Director and Principal Conductor

Swiss-native Michael Zaugg has distinguished himself as an innovative and versatile conductor, pedagogue and clinician. Currently in his 11th season as Artistic Director and Principal Conductor of the professional chamber choir Pro Coro Canada in Edmonton, Michael also previously led other notable Canadian choirs including, in Montreal, the St. Lawrence Choir (2008-2013) and voces boreales (2006- 2015), and the Cantata Singers Ottawa (2005-2014).

As Chorus Master of the Orchestre Symphonique de Montréal (2006-2011), Michael successfully prepared groups of up to 1500 singers for OSM Artistic Director Kent Nagano, including the award- winning production Saint François d'Assise by Messiaen. Michael also prepared the Cantata Singers Ottawa for their appearances with the National Arts Centre Orchestra under conductors such as Franz- Paul Decker, Trevor Pinnock, and Helmuth Rilling.

Active as a Guest Conductor, Michael Zaugg has worked with notable groups including the Vancouver Chamber Choir, National Youth Choir of Canada, the BBC Singers, Vancouver's musica intima, Thirteen Strings, as well as the Longueuil Symphony Orchestra. Michael's US debut was with the Grammy-nominated Choir of Trinity Wall Street in New York. He has led a 60-voice male choir, with singers selected from across Canada, the US and the Ukraine, to perform the Resurrection Liturgy by Fr. John



Sembrat (Alberta) in tours across the Prairies and to Toronto, Philadelphia, Rochester and New York City.

Originally an accomplished tenor, Michael became the first Swiss conductor to be accepted to the Royal Academy of Music in Stockholm, Sweden in its prestigious postgraduate program for Professional Choir Conducting. Mr. Zaugg also holds degrees in voice and music education from the University in Basel. In 2018 he was awarded an Honorary Degree of Doctor of Music (Hon DMus) by Scotland's King's College, University of Aberdeen.

In 2020 Michael Zaugg, together with Pro Coro Canada, received the Choral Canada national Award for Outstanding Innovation for the CHORAL ART at the Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity. He was also a 2020 recipient of the Edmonton Artists Trust Fund Award, and the recipient of the Con Spirito Award from Choir Alberta in 2022.

Pro Coro Canada



Founded in 1981 by Canadian Michel Marc Gervais, Pro Coro Canada has performed at the Toronto International Choral Festival (1994 and 2002), the 1988 Olympic Arts Festival, and Canadian Voices (2003 landmark series of concerts celebrating 50 years of professional choral singing in Canada and R. Murray Schafer's 70th year). The choir has commissioned dozens of new works, the majority by Canadian composers. Pro Coro Canada produced the second Edmonton International Choral Festival from May 30th to June 2nd, 2019.

The twenty-four voices of Pro Coro Canada have been shaped by some of the finest choral conductors in the world, including Gervais, Anders Eby (Sweden), Søren Hansen (Denmark), Agnes Grossmann (Austria), and Richard Sparks (USA). Guest conductors have included Frieder Bernius, Eric Ericson, Gary Graden, Maria Guinand, Bo Holten, Elmer Iseler, Tönu Kaljuste, Diane Loomer, Leonard Ratzlaff, Ward Swingle, Ivars Taurins, Jon Washburn, and Erik Westberg. In early 2012 Michael Zaugg was announced as Pro Coro's new Artistic Director and Principal Conductor.

Under the direction of Swiss-born Michael Zaugg, the choir is widely recognized as one of this country's finest. The choir is particularly proud of its composer-in-residence program with internationally renowned composer Alberto Grau; its appointment as Faculty in the Choral Art program at the Banff Centre; and critically acclaimed tours of four provinces. Pro Coro Canada believes strongly in community partnerships and over the past few years has collaborated with many community choirs as well as mentoring young choral artists through their Emerging Artist Program.



Guest Performers



Jacqueline Hernandez is a Chilean soprano who is completing a MMus in Voice Performance at the University of Alberta. She has a wide range of experience singing Opera, Art Songs, Baroque, and Chamber music. In 2016 she founded Latitud Ensamble committed to research, transcribe, and perform music from the early baroque period. With the Cantus Firmus Choir, she recorded part of the Ecuadorian Colonial Music catalog (Villancicos). She has worked as a voice pedagogue for 12 years and taught contemporary

commercial music and extended techniques for 10 years at a post-secondary level. A member of the Panamerican Vocology Association, she has several certifications in the field of vocology. Some of her performances include Mozart's Der Königin der Nacht, the concert version of West Side Story in the role of "Maria", "Madame Herz" in Mozart's Singspiel Der Schauspieldirektor.

Originally from Edmonton, mezzo soprano **Catherine Daniel** is a dynamic performer whose training and performances have taken her across North America and Europe. Career highlights for Ms. Daniel include: singing Emelda Griffiths in Grammy awardwinner Terence Blanchard's opera 'Champion' with l'Opéra



de Montréal, debuting Klytemnestra in Edmonton Opera's production of Elektra, singing Elisabetta in Knoxville Opera's production of Donizetti's Maria Stuarda, and debuting at Carnegie Hall as a soloist in Haydyn's Mass in Time of war. Ms. Daniel made her Opera Tampa debut in Carmen singing the title role in 2020. Ms Daniel studied voice with Coluratura soprano Tracy Dahl at the University of Manitoba. She was a member of the Atelier Lyrique de l'Opéra de Montréal, and later became a member of the Opera Studio Nederlands in Amsterdam.



The Juno Award-winning Tenor, John Tessier. has garnered international attention and praise for the beauty and honesty of his voice, for a refined style and artistic versatility, and for his handsome, youthful presence in the lyric tenor repertoire. He has worked with many of the most notable musicians of our day including Lorin Maazel, Leonard Slatkin, Plácido Domingo, John Nelson, Franz Welser-Möst, Donald Runnicles, Robert Spano, and Bernard Labadie. Equally

comfortable in the genres of opera, oratorio and recital, Mr. Tessier is also an award-winning professor at the University of Alberta and is in high demand for coaching, master classes, and private consultations. His discography includes recordings on the Decca, Naxos, Telarc, BIS, Challenge Records and Dorian labels.

Singing internationally in the US, Canada, Israel, Austria, and China; appearing in opera, concert, and oratorio; soloist at Carnegie Hall, dramatic baritone **Jin Yu** has brought his musical, vocal and dramatic skill, thrilling audiences and critics alike. From Bluebeard and Sparafucile to Don Alfonso and Count Almaviva, from Escamillo and Marcello to Gianni Schicchi, Jin Yu has sung over thirty roles, his dramatic interpretation and vocal agility make him equally at home as the villain, the romantic lead and the comic anti-hero. A towering presence in Handel and sacred



music, to Mozart and Verismo, Jin Yu's vocal and theatrical versatility is only matched by the Herculean size of his voice. With appearances in operas in Chinese as well, Jin Yu is the face of the new internationalism and versatility of the lyric art.



Jessica Robertson is a graduate of the University of Lethbridge with a Bachelor of Music degree in piano performance. Since moving to Edmonton in 2006, she has been busy as an accompanist for singers and various choir organizations in the city and maintaining piano and voice studios from her home. She spent several years as a collaborative pianist and coach for students in the voice program at the University of Alberta, and this past summer she was the musical director for Pop Goes the Opera's production of Suor Angelica. She is the accompanist for the University of Alberta Mixed Chorus and

sings with Pro Coro Canada and All Points West Chamber Choir. Jessica is currently pursuing an After Degree in Education from Concordia University of Edmonton.

Finnish accordionist **Matti Pulkki** performs frequently with different chamber groups and as a soloist around the world. Recently he has focused on collaborating with composers on renewing the soundscape of the instrument through experimentation. Pulkki primarily concentrates on original music written for accordion, and also arranges, transcribes, and performs music from a wide range of styles and works as a creative artist and musician on diverse projects from interdisciplinary productions to music theatre and opera. Pulkki holds a Master's degree from the Sibelius Academy



of the University of the Arts Helsinki and is currently pursuing his doctorate at the University of Toronto, studying with professor Joseph Macerollo.





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Endowment Funds create a permanent legacy felt over generations.
